The Liendo mansion was completed in 1853, the surrounding property became one of Texas' earliest & most successful cotton plantations. Liendo remained a location of activity during the American Civil War when it served as a Cavalry & Infantry training camp site, an internment camp & even a hospital. Following the war, General George Custer & his men camped on the grounds for several months. Liendo is now recognized as a State & National historic landmark continuing to preserve & share Texas & America's history. Join us for an up close & personal look at the life and times of America during the 1860's.
